

## Teacher Highlights





Chestnut Class have been busy doing their home learning. Everyone has been working so hard and we can't wait to be back in our classroom on Monday.




In Year 1 we have learnt how to write recipes. We created recipes for how to be a good friend and for delicious sandwiches! It made us very hungry!

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
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**4S** have been getting crafty and learning how to sew, we are stitching our own 'monster' stuffed toys!
