Food Bank Aid performs an essential role in our local community, supplying 17 food banks in North London, including our local ones of Hornsey (N8), Bounds Green (N8), The Hive (N19) and Impact Cuisine (N19). It estimates to help feed 12,000 people, 3,000 of whom children, and your donations will be greatly appreciated as families lose the school means provision during the impending half term.

The collection will take place from Monday, 18 October, until Friday 22 October. Please help us support this charity by bringing your donations to school, at drop off (only) next week. Donation stations will be signposted at the main gates.

Fun family activities for the half-term holidays



3P have enjoyed finding facts about ancient Egypt using the iPad in our computing lesson.





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
This Week's Highlights

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
