



Chestnut Class have been making caterpillar patterns in Maths.




Beech class have been working hard this week, taking away using a number line. Some children have made their own number lines.

4C have been reading the Spiderwick Chronicles and we have really enjoyed creating our own mythical creatures. This amazing piece was completed by Donovan.








A tough week in 4P learning multiple ways of solving division problems. We are on the way to mastery using counters, pictures, number lines and abstract calculating methods.
