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## This week's highlights




**Chestnut class made some delicious garlic bread**

**Ash Class have been writing an eye witness account. In this case, it is the eye witness account of what the wolf did at the house of bricks of the three little pigs.**




**In 3P we have started a new computing topic on animation. We have explored making flip books and making an image move. It was great fun.**






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## This week's highlights
