Anti-Bully Week & Odd Socks Day


We are starting our Anti-Bullying Week with **Odd Socks Day**. This is a great way to celebrate what makes us all unique in Anti-Bullying Week!



In Drama Club the children worked as a team to make shapes with their bodies. Here the students making a car with their bodies! Great teamwork St Peters!



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


In 5A, factor bugs were creeping around this week. We used
