3P have been using place value counters to work out unit fractions of a set of objects.



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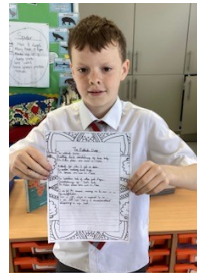
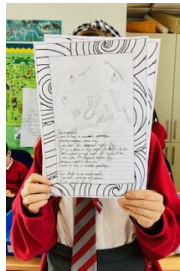
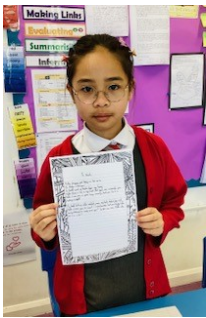
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4T have been creating sense poems and using role play in literacy.
