Dear Parents & Carers,

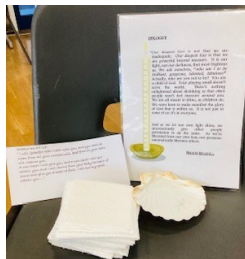

The children in 3P have loved reading the book 'Firebird' and have created some beautiful art work and have written some amazing descriptions.



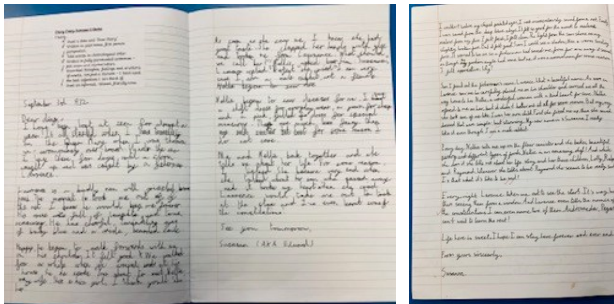
