## Happy Bag Collection

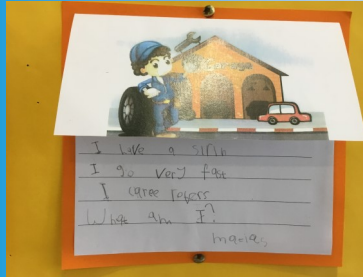
Happy Bag School Day raised £64.80 across both schools. On behalf of the Friends, we thank everyone for their continued support and donations!



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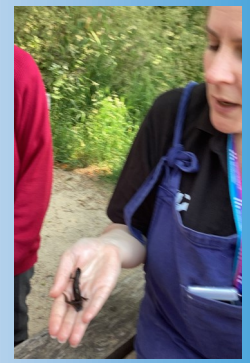
## This week's highlights...



Our topic for this half term is Vehicles and Transport. We painted pictures of our favourite vehicles and wrote some 'What am I?' riddles. Can you solve our riddles?



Ash Class have started to learn about the Neolithic Age, which is also known as the New Stone Age.



4T have started their first week back at school with flourish. This week they had the opportunity to put on their scientific hats and observe plants and animals in our local habitat by visiting Woodberry Wetlands. Walking through the peaceful oasis in central London, we saw jewelled blue dragonflies, butterflies and hoverflies. on our minibeast hunt we found a spider and a stag beetle! For many children, the best part of the trip was pond dipping and getting up close and personal with newts.



As part of our bee project, 3P have been using watercolour to paint their own bees. They have been mixing colours to create different shades.

- \* item for our bug hotel - bricks, drain piping, flower pots (not plastic please )

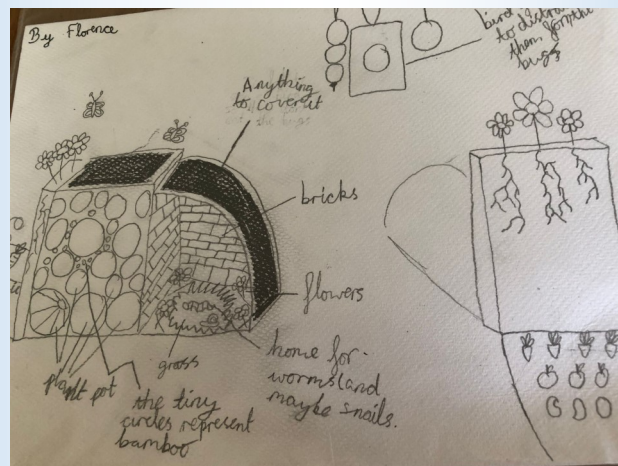
Walk with us!

- \* can you spare some time as some of the work is too heavy for the children?

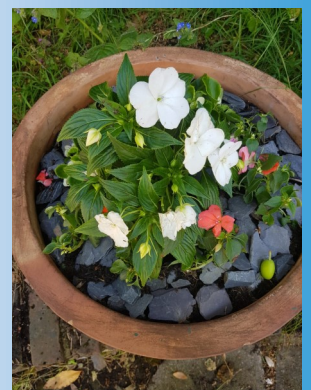
