SCHOOL BUILDING FUND

At St. Peter's and St. Gildas' we are extremely grateful for the contributions we receive from many families towards the School Building Fund. We feel blessed to have such a supportive community and your financial support is greatly appreciated.

Voluntary Aided Schools such as ours are required by law to provide 10% of the cost themselves towards all repairs, maintenance and development of school buildings. Funding we receive from general taxation covers only 90% of these costs. Therefore, the School Building Fund is essential for us to manage the day-to-day repairs and general upkeep of the school property.

That's why we ask every family who can afford it to make a voluntary contribution of £60 per pupil per year (£5 per month). We are grateful for every contribution, great or small, and if you are able to contribute more, your generosity would be greatly welcome.

Gift aid

Anyone who pays income tax at the basic or higher rate can increase the amount the schools receive by completing the attached Gift Aid form. If you Gift Aid your donation, the schools will receive an additional 25p per £1 donated. Any taxpayer in the family can sign the declaration. If you filled out a form last year you don't need to do so again unless your home address has changed. Gift Aid costs you nothing but is an easy way to make your School Building Fund contribution go even further.
