This week has been a bit like our weather, at points lovely then other times a little sad. I have seen wonderful learning taking place across the school. Everything from algebra to drawing tulips.


Unfortunately, the sad news is that this week Mrs Martins-Mitchell will be leaving St Peter's and St Gildas', we wish her the best of luck in the future.
