Family Stations of The Cross – This service will be held in our Parish Church St Peter-in-Chains at 10.30am on Good Friday.

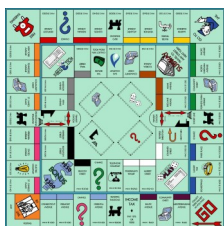
If any children from Year 3 and above would like to read or take part in a freeze frame for individual stations, please let me know via the school office.

Have a lovely weekend celebrating Mother's Day.

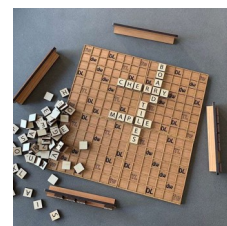
