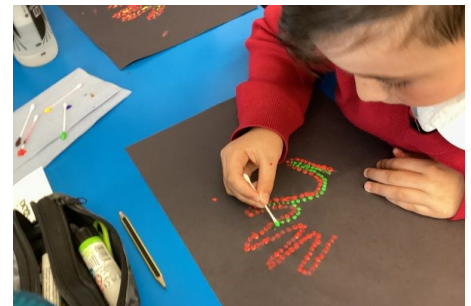
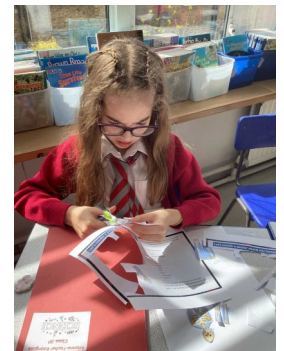
Year R / 1 enjoyed a lovely walk to Crouch End to look at the local buildings and human and physical features.
