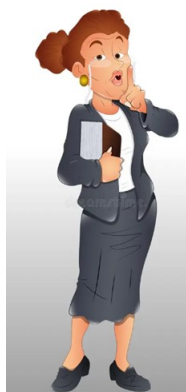

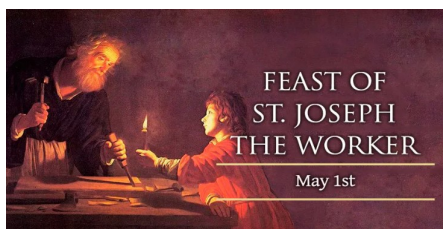

Message from Mr O'Shannessy



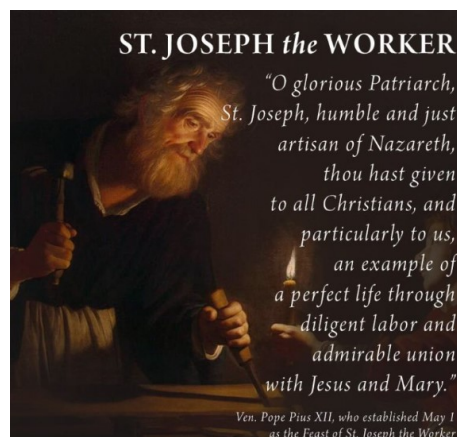
