This reminds me of Jesus' commandment that we should, Love God with all our heart but equally we should love one another as he loved us.

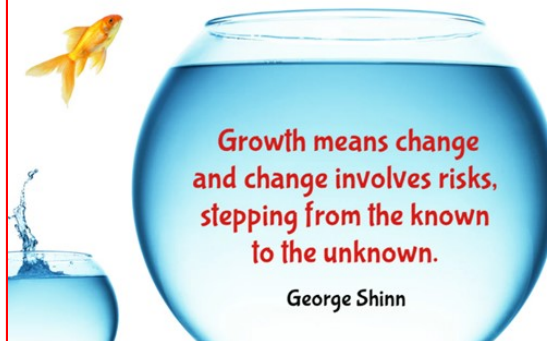
**OFSTED** This week we can celebrate the wonderful OFSTED report that we received for St Gildas'. We now have to patiently wait for the news for St Peter's.

This week, Year 3 have started presenting their projects about volcanoes. Everyone has been very creative and presented their work beautifully.

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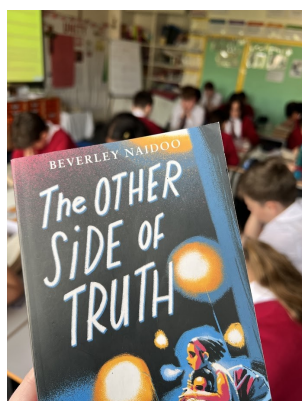
